Welcome to the launch of the Colorado Fatherhood Initiative e-newsletter! The purpose of this newsletter is to create a communication hub for fatherhood-related programs, projects, and groups across Colorado.

The Family Resource Center Association (FRCA) was approached at the beginning of the year by a group of long-time supporters, partners and practitioners affiliated with Colorado's Fatherhood Network about the possibility of FRCA becoming the new home for this valuable work in Colorado. We were very excited about this opportunity and wanted to be intentional and thoughtful about how we could best support the Initiative going forward.

In June, FRCA launched the first phase of this project, *Research*, with a sixmonth information-gathering survey effort with the goals of:

- Understanding the landscape of supports already in place for Colorado fathers, as well as gaps in services
- Identifying best practices for fatherhood support programs
- Developing recommendations for moving this work forward in Colorado

Thank you to the many stakeholders who participated in this phase of the project! Now that the report is complete, we will be reaching out to the different stakeholder groups that participated and sharing back the results specific to your region and group.
