


Colorado Fatherhood Initiative Report - 2020


Early Childhood Councils

The Family Resource Center Association (FRCA) conducted a statewide inventory of fatherhood services in the Fall of 2020 in their role as the Fatherhood State Intermediary to help plan the best way to strategically move this important initiative forward. The Early Childhood Councils (ECC) were invited to participate in this effort. Sixteen ECEs completed a survey that indicated nine of those councils, serving ten counties, have fatherhood services in their counties. Four of the ECCs directly provide one or more of those programs. In the second figure, you can see that up to ten councils expressed interest in expanding or adding the services seen below (if all barriers were removed), indicating potential unmet needs in the counties they serve:

NETWORK SUPPORTS

FRCA will provide network supports to all organizations providing fatherhood programs in Colorado. On average, program implementation support was most important to the reporting ECCs with evaluation, peer support, resource development and organizational capacity building important to over 70% of these ECCs.
