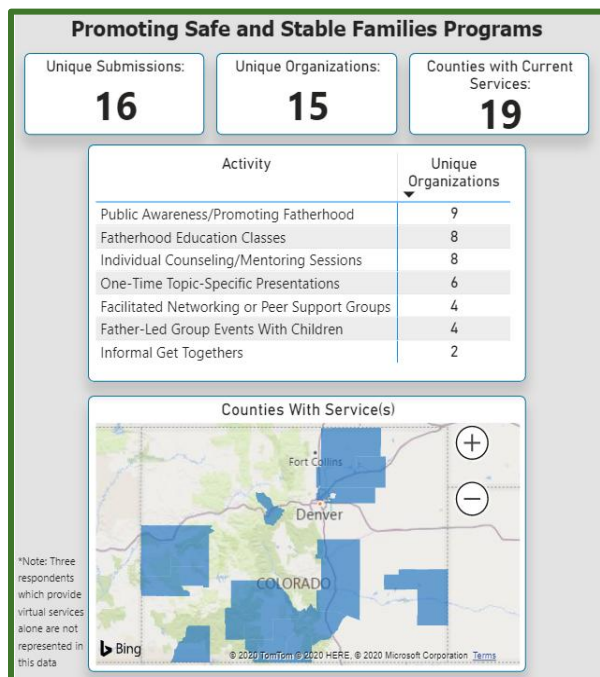


Colorado Fatherhood Initiative Report - 2020

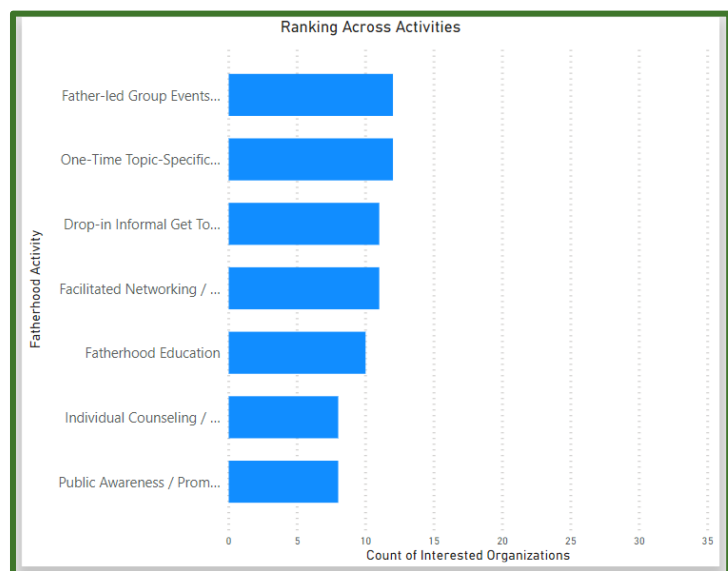
Promoting Safe and Stable Families

The Family Resource Center Association conducted a statewide inventory of fatherhood services in the Fall of 2020 in their role as the Fatherhood State Intermediary to help plan the best way to strategically move this important initiative forward. The Promoting Safe and Stable Programs (PSSFP) were invited to participate in this effort. Twenty-one PSSFPs completed a survey that indicates 15 are currently providing fatherhood services as seen below. Of the 21 which responded, the second figure indicates the number that would be interested in providing services if all barriers were removed, potentially indicating an unmet need in their service areas:

NETWORK SUPPORTS

FRCA will provide network supports to all organizations providing fatherhood programs in Colorado. On average, over 85% indicated that program implementation, peer support and communication were important to their organizations. Well over 60% also reported that evaluation, resource development, network participation and capacity building were important.
